1. Entries should comprise of the completed application form and a 5 minute (max) sample of the programme on audio CD/MP3's highlighting the key features of the programme.
2. Only one application can be made PER category and up to a maximum of TWO per CORE or ROTATING. E.g You could enter Specialist Music from Rotating and Social Gain and Irish Language from Core.
3. Closing Date is 12pm Friday 21<sup>st</sup> December 2010. Results will be announced on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> December at a special Christmas Mull Wine and Mince Wine reception at the Ramada Hotel, Shaws Bridge, Belfast.

5. Assessors/Judges may decide to award more than one award in any category or may decide not to make any award in a particular category. The assessors/judges will consist of members of community media sector along with independent community and radio professionals.
6. All entries will be considered as stand alone efforts and, depending on the strength of their entry, be awarded either a distinction or merit certificate, or in some instances.
7. Remember, these Awards are to recognise effort and achievement – they are not a competition to judge one station over another. Every community radio station is focused on the needs of its own community rather than on the needs of a community served by another station. Therefore the performance, resources and output of all stations are different – these Awards recognise and celebrate this fact.
